Some other state pageants charge as much as \$1,500 to win a state title. Our state pageant entry fee is only \$295.00. Our contestants can either sell donation tickets or sell ads in the program book to cover these fees so they won't have to pay this out of their own pockets. Also email the director about sibling discounts! Also we make sure no one goes home empty-handed.

PAGEANT SCHEDULE: We will be following a strict schedule at the state pageant. Early Registration will be from 12-7 p.m. Friday afternoon/night, Sept. 18, 2026 (you will receive your specific age group time to registration closer to the pageant) and an emergency registration on September 19, 2026 from 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. (must be approved by director) Beauty



competition will be first on September 19 and will between 9 a.m. until 2 p.m. Casual wear will be from 2 p.m. to 7 p.m. You will be given your schedule at registration with your exact times. You will have PLENTY of time to go back to your hotel to get ready. Crowning is September 20 Sunday morning. Always watch the Miss Magnolia State Pageant Page on Facebook for updates!!!

General Information

The pageant will be held in Vicksburg, Mississippi on September 19-20, 2026. The pageant will be held at the historic Vicksburg City Auditorium in downtown Vicksburg at 901 Monroe Street. You may book any hotel room in Vicksburg you wish. We will not be using any particular host hotels.

Remember we ONLY allow contestants who WON their preliminary pageant to compete at the state pageant or sponsored by an official Miss Magnolia State Pageant local director or the state director. Your age division will be determined as of September 1, 2026. There will be a SMALL grace period for the state pageant. The grace period will be Sept. 1, 2026. So what this mean is if your birthday is Sept. 1 or after, you will be able to stay in the younger division. If your birthday is August 31 or earlier, you will advance up to the older division.

- Examples...... If a 3 year old has her 4th birthday on August 31, 2026, she will move up to the 4-5 year old division at the state pageant.
- If a 3 year old has her 4th birthday on Sept. 1, 2026, she will get to stay in the 2-3 division at the state pageant, known as a grace period (Sept. 1 through Sept. 20 is the small grace period).
- If an 11 year old turns 12 on or before September 1, 2026, she will compete in the Junior Miss Magnolia State Pageant (12-14) in November instead of the 9-11 Pre-Teen Division in September. Is she turns 12 after Sept. 1, she could remain in the 9-11 division. Email the director if you have any questions about your age division. You might move up to the next division at the state pageant if your child turned a year older after his/her local pageant win and does not meet the grace period. State winners may compete again the next year, only if they are in the next age group from which they won. Contestants must live in Mississippi, parent works in Mississippi or have immediate relatives living in Mississippi to be eligible for the state pageant. Immediate relatives include grandparents, a parent, sibling or aunt or uncle. If you are from out of state and meet the eligiblity requirements to compete, you will need to fill out the Eligibility Page of this application and mail it in also.

Winners of each of the age divisions will receive the Gorgeous Little Miss Magnolia State Crown, 5 ft. tall trophy, and monogrammed banner. All contestants will receive trophies, gifts and their official local crown on stage. These winners are chosen from the beauty and casual wear competitions combined. All 6 of our girl winners will each receive a \$1,000 cash prize. Our boy winners will each win a \$250 cash prize unless they have at least 20 in a group (if at least 20 in a boy division, then their cash prize will be raised to \$1,000 as well). Boys are hard to recruit. Must have 3 per division or boy divisions will be combined.

We will still have our Overall Side Awards for fun!!! You are required bring a charity market gift for our charity auction. Your gift needs to be something that will sell for at least \$25. Examples pottery, something crafty or cool made in your area of the state, toys kids would want, gift baskets, etc.. just anything that will sell. A portion of our proceeds will go to our chosen charity and a portion will help to send our older winners in November on their trip to Europe!! If you forget your gift, you may turn in \$25 cash to be eligible for the overall awards which are mandatory.

Overall Photogenic - Winner receives large crown, monogrammed banner, and a large trophy. (One photo included with this price. Additional photos are \$5.00 each to turn in for judging). You can turn in as many extra pictures as you like (you may turn them in as late as registration on that Friday). Judges will only judge their favorite picture. Age group winners receive a glass framed award.

Overall Best Fashion - Winner receives large crown, monogrammed banner, and a large trophy. Age group winners will receive a glass framed award. **Overall Most Beautiful/Most Handsome** - Winners receive a large crown, monogrammed banner and a large trophy. Winners will not be called out in each group for this award. **Ambassador Award** -(Only awards chosen by the director. Based on good-sportsmanship, personality and determination) To be eligible for an Amabassador Award, a contestant must have competed at state for a minimum of 3 years.











Areas of Competition: There are <u>two</u> areas of competition to determine the winners: both casual wear and beauty competition count 50% each. Yes all contestants will compete in these two competitions.

PARENTS: If you are walking your child out on stage this year, ages 0-5 are required to, we ask the parents to wear black shirt and black pants or dress this year on Saturday, so they do not distract the judges from the children on stage. ALSO we ask you wear the all black outfit again on Sunday for crowning to make the crowning ceremonies look more uniform. Thank you. Kids wear their same beauty outfit again on Sunday for crowning.

- Casual Wear Competition We are NOT looking for total glitz in casual wear. Our former rule was NO GLITZ but we will allow MINOR exceptions since many clothes you can buy from Wal-Mart have beads or sequins. If it is too glitzy the judges will count off. Do not go overboard with glitz like a national pageant or points will be deducted. Modeling is **not** being judged unless you go overboard with a national level routine then points will be deducted. A couple kisses etc is fine but if you go into a full routine, points could easily be deducted. Small props are fine (purse, hat, fan, etc) if they are minor and something the contestant can carry on their own.
- Beauty Competition Our state pageant is different from others. Since we conduct our preliminary pageants with no national level glitz pageant dresses for the younger contestants, we will keep it that way at the state pageant. Our contestants ages 11 and under must wear Sunday dresses, Easter type dresses, very mild baby doll dresses or flower girl type dresses. Flower girl dresses should not touch the floor. Ankle length is as long as the dress should be. A dress will not help you win this pageant only the fashion award. Absolutely no glitzed out pageant dresses for ages 11 and under. We want all the girls on the same level with their clothing. Again do NOT wear glitzed pageant dresses. There is a difference in a sequin dress from a department store and custom made glitzed dress. A rhinestone strip or belt is Ok. A rhinestone strap is ok. If you question your dress, you can send an email to the director. You will only hurt your child if you go overboard. You will be REQUIRED to bring your competition dress to registration on Friday to have it approved before the pageant begins. Hairpieces and falls and fake teeth are NOT allowed at state pageant this year. It is the parents choice for makeup application but we are not allowing fake eyelashes or spray tans this year. We are more of a natural pageant and want to keep it that way. Girls have been disqualified for wearing fake hair at the state pageant. If you are disqualifed for breaking the rules, no refunds will be given. Don't chance it! Just let your daughter be her adorable self. That is what we want!

Tickets will be sold at the door for family and friends who want to come cheer on their favorite contestants. Weekend Adult Badges for Saturday's competition and Sunday's crowning are \$30.00 - total for the entire weekend, both days - and children 10 and under are \$15.00, three and younger are free. For anyone not purchasing a weekend pass may buy tickets for one day at the door the day of the pageant separtely for \$20 for adults per day and \$10 for kids per day. PLEASE NOTE THAT TICKETS MAY BE PURCHASED AT THE DOOR EACH DAY but it's much cheaper to buy a weekend pass. To attend the pageant for both days there is a discounted armband you may purchase at registration for \$30 per person. These fees are required so we can rent the auditorium for a first class production. PARENTS MUST PAY. Only contestants will be admitted free. All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable if contestants fail to show for the state pageant or decide to withdraw. If you pay all your fees and are unable to attend last minute, all of your fees will transfer over to the next year's state pageant except for a \$50 reinstatement fee. Your state fee credit will be good for one year. If your ad in the program book ran the year before, you would have to buy the ad the second time if you want it to be reran in the new program book. Also if you require a new title on your banner, a new banner would need to be purchased. We make sure all kids go home with awards and goodies!!!

MAKE SURE YOU UNDERSTAND....

- You compete in <u>TWO</u> competitions at the state pageant. Sunday wear beauty competition and casual wear competition. Your casual wear can be off the rack <u>OR</u> custom made. No custom glitz in casual wear. Sparkle is ok if it was on your outfit that came like that from Dillards, Wal-Mart etc. Do not have a routine in casual wear. Just walk to your X's. Purses, hats, sunglasses, etc are ok. Make sure you go to the website www.missmagnoliastate.com and watch the highlight video of the state pageant in the video archives. It will answer lots of your questions about clothing.
- Your beauty dress SHOULD NOT BE OVER THE TOP. We are not looking for anything that resembles a national level pageant dress (toddlers and tiaras type). Our rules are Sunday dress, flower girl dress that does not touch the floor, Easter type dress and this year will are allowing **SIMPLE** baby doll dress with no glitz or stones. If your dress has a pearl or a sequin here or there, it's going to be ok. We are just trying to keep everyone on the same level. You guys know what we want so please don't try to cross the line. Below is an example of a baby doll dress that would pass. Anything fancier than this is too much. **THIS YEAR EVERYONE MUST BRING THEIR DRESS TO REGISTRATION TO BE APPROVED**. You should bring a back up dress if you think your dress is too much!
- NO fake hair, no fake teeth (flippers), no fake eyelashes and no spray tans this year. We want these kids natural and having fun. Parent may let their kids wear make up if they want to and of course you can fix their hair however you choose, just no fake fair. The only time we can allow fake hair is if a child is undergoing cancer treatments or African-American contestants that have hair already woven in for a day-to-day basis that was not put in just for the pageant. We even allow a light bronzer but no dark spray tans on kids.
- Everyone is required to bring a charity market gift this year to registration to enter the Overall Fashion, Overal Most Beautiful and Overall Photogenic awards. We do this for our older girl pageant each November and it's fun and successful. If you forget your gift, you will need to pay \$25 at the door to enter the overall events. It is mandatory.
- If you have not LIKED our Facebook page, go find MISS MAGNOLIA STATE PAGEANT on facebook and follow us on that page. We have listed all of the contestants in ads to promote them and provide updates on that page. Also in September, we will open up the Viewer's Choice Competition where the kids can compete for the most votes. Winners will receive prizes and be recognized on stage.
- Parents remember to wear ALL BLACK if you are walking your child out ages 0-5. Also this year we want you to wear all BLACK on Saturday and Sunday. Thanks.
- Our pageant photographer, John McDonald, will be offering stage shots of your child on stage. He charges approx. \$25. You will own all photos for the one fee. He will have a table set up during registration on Friday for you to order.
- Photogenic. If you emailed me your photos you WILL STILL need to bring a printed photo for this competition. If you want to enter extra pics to be judged, you may do so for \$5 each at registration. Remember it is not the pageant's responsibility to print out pics.
- You may also go on our website and view the highlight video from last year's pageant at missmagnoliastate.com













PROGRAM BOOK ADVERTISING – HOW TO ENTER FREE AND WIN THE AD CROWN

There will be an attractive, professionally produced program book at the pageant. Ad pages are \$180 for a full page; \$90 for a half a page; and \$45 for ¼ page. Contestants may sell ads to family, friends and businesses. It is easy to earn your entry free by selling just a few ads. This way, the expense of the pageant will not come out of your own pocket and you are giving merchants in your community the chance to be recognized. EVERY CONTESTANT IN THE PAGEANT IS REQUIRED TO SELL 1/4 PAGE. For those of you just selling your required 1/4 page ad, all you have to do is draw out on a sheet of paper what you want to appear on your ad and we will get our graphic artist to typeset and create the ad for you at no additional charge for the set up. Please include a photo to use on your ad, photos may be professional or snapshots and maye be with or without crown or sash. For those selling MORE than the required 1/4 page ad, you must have your ads set up and have them camera ready (already typeset with photos placed on page) to send in this year. The pageant will not be setting up your pages this year. Everyone has a friend or local printer that can

create the ad pages on the computer. You will need to send them in to the office as a jpeg or pdf file through email. Send ads to MSPageantnews@aol.com Do not send your ads to us printed out on paper. We would then have to scan them in and they would not look good. Ads need to be sent to us in a high resolution format. If ads are created on an iphone or a program in a small file and then you send them to us and we have to make them bigger, they will come our blurry. This book is a great souvenir to keep throughout the years. If you need someone to set up your pages, you may contact Amanda McCarthy at 662-255-3543 or email her at ack1218@gmail.com.... she only charges around \$10 per page for set up. <u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> 3 pages of ads sold (\$540) will earn you a free entry. See the next pages for more information on ad sales.

Any contestant selling 3 pages may enter the pageant free! (Smaller ads can added up to make full pages, can be 1/4, 1/2 as long as the grand total EQUALS 3 full pages.) Your required 1/4 page ad IS included if you decide to sell the 3 pages. Any contestant selling 5 pages may enter the pageant free and receive a 3 foot tall trophy and beautiful Rhinestone Ad Sales Crown for his/her hard work. For any contestant selling over 7 pages will receive a Miss Magnolia State sceptor in addition to to their crown and trophy. For any contestant selling 10 pages this year, they will receive their ad sales crown, a GIANT 5 foot tall deluxe trophy, a Miss Magnolia State sceptor and \$100 cash back. ALL ADS MUST BE TURNED IN BY YOUR DEADLINE TO MEET THE PRINTER'S DEADLINE. If you are selling multiple pages of ads and need more time, contact the director for a deadline extension.

ANOTHER WAY TO ENTER FREE— DONATION TICKETS

We will be giving away gifts from a drawing of all Donation Tickets turned in. The tickets are only 50¢ each. To enter the pageant free you only need to sell 600 tickets which will be \$300. Just take this sheet of tickets and have it copied. We are trying to make this State Pageant affordable for everyone so that every child will have a chance to compete at this level. If you sell tickets, you are still responsible for selling ONE one-fourth page ad in the program book.

YOUR LOCAL TITLE FOR THE STATE PAGEANT

Every contestant at the state pageant will have a local title this year. If you won a local title at your preliminary pageant, that will be your local title for the state pageant. Everyone must pay a \$20 Banner Fee this year. We will be having custom-made monogrammed banners for your child to wear during the crowning ceremonies only on Sunday. Email the director if you have any questions about your local title.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT FORM

(Only needed for contestants with a mailing address outside of Mississippi)

The Little Miss and Mr. Magnolia State Pageant does allow contestants to compete with an out of state mailing address as long as they do met the pageant's requirements.

One of the contestant's parents or step-parents must live, work, or physically (not online) go to school in Mississippi. Parent may also be a local director for the Miss Magnolia State Pageant that conducts their pageant in Mississippi to be eligible.

Contestant could also have an immediate relative that lives in Mississippi to make them eligible. Our definition of an immediate relative would be a parent, sibling, aunt or uncle or grandparent. Other relatives such as cousins, godparents, etc would not qualify you to compete in the Little Miss & Mr. Magnolia State Pageant.

We just have to keep everything fair and make sure everyone is following the same rules. You will need to list your relative or what makes you eligible to compete in our state pageant. You will also need to have this form notarized by a notary.

Program Book Pages

Selling advertisements (ads) in the program book is a great way to raise your entry fee so you don't have to pay out of pocket. By selling ads to businesses in your community, they can gain some exposure in our state program book and help you with sponsorships. By selling 3 full pages of ads in the book, your entry fee is covered. You do not have to pay the \$295.00 entry fee if you are selling three pages of ads. Three full pages of ads totals \$540. It is a little more this way because the printer charges us for every page that is in the program book. If you are selling 3 full pages, your required 1/4 page ad is included in your 3 pages. You can sell as many pages as you would like to. Five pages, seven pages and even ten pages offer some extra awards for the contestants. The contestant that sales the most ads will be featured on the website. (You will still be responsible for your \$20 banner fee and \$75 production fee though).

If you are selling more than your requried 1/4 page ad page, your pages must come in CAMERA READY this year. Camera Ready means already set up and just needs to be placed in the program book. In the past, we have set up your pages for you as a courtesy, but due to time restrictions we will no longer be able to offer that service free.

Everyone knows someone that is good on the computer or you may even find a local printer in your town that can set up your pages for you. You will need to have your pages set up, with your photos already scanned in on the pages, business cards scanned in and wording and artwork set up the way you want it. The top of your ad should have your name and your local title printed on it. See the example included in this packet to go by. It needs to be email to us in a jpeg or pdf file for us to drop in our program book files. Do not send iphone created ads with small resolution or any type of program using small resolution. When we enlarge those ads, they tend to blur. Make sure what you send in, is high resolution.

The \$10 Signature Listing ads can be added up to make bigger ads. For example, 4 and 1/2 signature listings could make a \$45 1/4 page ad, 9 of them could make an \$901/2 page ad, or 18 of them could make a \$180 full page ad.

This is a 1/2 page ad \$90.00

Then of course there is the whole page ad for \$180.00

If selling ads to cover your entry fee here is the breakdown to make it easy to understand......

- If selling the minimum required \$45 1/4 page ad in the program book, you will also need to turn in your \$20 banner fee, \$75 production fee and \$295 entry fee for a grand total of \$425.
- If you sell ONE page of ads, there isn't any discount, you will need to turn in your \$180 for a full page ad, \$20 banner fee, \$75 production fee and \$295 entry fee for a grand total of \$570
- If you sell TWO full pages of ads, you will be allowed to deduct \$150 commission for your ad sales. You would need to turn in your \$295 entry fee, \$20 banner fee, and \$75 production fee, plus your 2 pages of ads (\$180x2 is \$360). That total would be \$750 minus your \$150 commission would be a grand total of \$600 to send in.
- If you sell THREE full pages of ads, you will will not pay the \$295 entry fee. You will need to turn in your 3 pages of ads (\$180x3=\$540) plus your \$20 banner fee and \$75 production fee for a total of \$635.
- If you sell FIVE or more full pages of ads, you do have to pay your \$295 entry fee. You will still need to pay in your \$20 banner fee and \$75 production fee and \$180 for every ad page sold. So that total would be \$995. Any contestant selling 5 or more pages will at least win a 3 foot tall trophy and ad sales crown to be presented on stage during crowning.





EXTRA PROGRAM BOOK ORDER FORM

Every contestant will receive ONE free program book for entering the pageant. Every year we run out of extra books to sell to family and supporters. Our printing fees have gone up this year so we are unable to get that many extra books printed. Our program book is thick like a telephone book and we be sold this year for \$20 per copy.
